



Categories for **Fynbos** QUILT-In 2016

1. Traditional

- Size: no side smaller than 120cm or longer than 250cm
- Quilts made and designed by an individual that have been constructed using traditional techniques and materials and have a conventional edge finish (no raw edges). Quilts can be pieced or appliquéd or a combination of both.
- The quilt must be your own design or a design derived from using elements from the public domain. It cannot be a copy of another quilt/art work or made from a commercial quilt pattern.

2. Pictorial

- Size: No side longer than 200cm.
- Quilts that are a depiction/representation of (a) person(s), (a) place(s) and /or (a) thing(s). The representation can be realistic or stylised. Any technique(s) can be used.
- The quilt must be your own design or a design derived from using elements from the public domain. It cannot be a copy of another quilt/art work or made from a commercial quilt pattern.

3. Open A or Open B

The Open category provides a place for quilts that do not fit in the other categories. The quilts must not violate copyright laws. Any technique or combination of techniques can be used.

- Size: No side longer than 250cm.

The following quilts can be entered:

A) Quilts constructed and quilted by an individual AND

- made using a published/commercial pattern (including so called “Modern” quilts) or designed by another individual for you or
- made using computer-digitized quilting and/or machine embroidery patterns or
- have been started in a class or
- be a replica of an antique quilt (made approximately before 1960) or
- made from non-quilted traditional techniques (Yo-yo’s, Cathedral Window etc).

B) Collaborative Quilts - any quilt that is constructed (pieced, appliquéd, quilted, embellished or finished) by two or three individuals.

4. Table Runner

- Size: width between 35cm and 50cm and the length no more than 120cm.
- Item should be suitable as a table runner, made of 3 layers and quilted through all the layers.

5. Challenge THEME: Mountains and Trees – Berge en Bome

- Size: no side may be longer than 120cm or less than 50cm in either landscape or portrait layout..
- The challenge fabric must be included in the front of the quilt and may not be dyed, or changed.

Rules of the Competition

This is a Judged Quilt competition.

There are several categories - Make sure your quilt entry meets the criteria of the category you choose to enter it in.

1. Any technique or combination of techniques may be used.
2. All entries must consist of 3 layers and be quilted through all 3 layers.
3. Only individuals may enter and entries must be made and quilted by one person only, except for the Open Category – section 3 B: Collaborative Quilts.
4. Quilt-makers may enter no more than 3 quilts in each category.
5. No copies or kits are allowed, nor replicas of quilts made after 1960.
6. In the Challenge category the theme is “*Mountains and Trees - Berge en Bome*”.
7. **Credits:** All design and inspiration credits must be declared. Colour photographs and/or photocopies of inspirations/designs must be placed in an envelope and pinned to the back of the quilt.
8. **Label:** A fabric label containing the quilt title, maker's name, address, contact details and date must be sewn to the bottom left corner on the back of the quilt. Tack a dark piece of fabric over the label to cover all the information except the quilt title.
9. A sleeve on your quilt is optional.

Note: GHQG reserves the right to display the competition quilts, to the best advantage possible, subject to the space available.

Competition Entry Fee Payments

Entry fee: R50.00 per quilt or item entered in the judged competition, except for the Themed Challenge quilt entries where R70 has been paid for the fabric pack.

Important Information

- **Quilt Exhibition:** Quilts will be on display at Bloemhof School in Stellenbosch from 2pm on Wednesday 5 October to 3pm on Saturday 8 October 2016.
- **Winners:** The competition winners will be announced at a special function during the FYNBOS Quilt-In the Boland on Thursday 6 October 2016.
- **Prizes:** Voucher and or Cash prizes for First, Second and Third positions will be awarded as well as certificates and ribbons.
- **Judging:** The Competition quilts will be judged by SAQG Accredited Quilt Judges. Each entry will receive a written commentary. The Judges' decision is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- **The Viewer's Choice Award** will be presented at the November GHQG meeting.

- **Risk:** While every care will be taken by the organizers, the quilts will be exhibited at the Fynbos exhibition at the risk of the owners. Owners must make their own insurance arrangements.
- **Deadline date for Entry forms and entry fee to be paid - 12 SEPTEMBER 2016**
- **Deadline date for delivery of quilts - 19 SEPTEMBER 2016.**
No late entries will be accepted.
