



With every quarterly meeting we are going to highlight a few books! February's book is:




Millefiori Quilts - Willyne Hammerstein

We were very lucky to get hold of the first book on Millefiori by Willyne Hammerstein.

A Millefiori quilt is an interpretation of the beautiful Venetian Millefiori glass. In English Millefiori means a thousand flowers. This 184-page book features the famous La Passacaglia pattern, but there are also 19 other unique English Paper Piecing projects, mostly designed around the hexagon.



A quilter remarked: This is one of the most difficult quilts, but making it is a fascinating pleasure. Good luck and have fun!



Angle Play Blocks - Margaret J Miller

If you like triangle or star shaped quilts - this book is for you! In this book the writer shows you how to make different triangle templates (starting with a rectangle). With these templates she introduces you to 84 easy, different blocks.

Step by step photos guide the way.

THE GLENDAY QUILT PATTERN



The original early-mid 19th century quilt is in the collection of the Iziko Social History Centre in Cape Town. The pattern has been produced with the kind permission of the Iziko Museums of South Africa. Ronél Pistorius and Diana Vandeyar have worked together to bring to you this amazing opportunity to make a part of South African quilting history. The 22-page pattern includes photos and history of the original quilt, detailed instructions, and full-size appliqué templates. All proceeded from the sale of the pattern go to the GHQG Festival fund. A limited number of paper patterns will be available at the May meeting. Price: R150.
