Join the hive! Let's come together as a community of creative makers to build a stunning, collaborative beehive, one hexagon at a time!

We're inviting all quilters, crafters, and artists to design a 41/2" hexagon (flat side at the top) and decorate it in any way you like. Your hexagon will be part of a massive art installation, celebrating the beauty of the West Coast Biome, from flowers and birds to fossils and insects.


During the festival, the completed hexagons will be **sold or donated** to support community outreach projects. This is your chance to leave your mark and make a difference!

How to Participate

- Create a hexagon (4½″ sides, flat edge at the top).
- Use fabric as a base—or surprise us with something unique!
- Decorate using any craft technique—embroidery, beading, painting, appliqué, quilting, mixed media... anything goes! (If using delicate materials, please stabilize your piece.)
- Finish the edges neatly, and stick to the final size of 4½"
- Sign your name somewhere on the front.
- Attach a 4" strip of hook-side Velcro 1 cm from the top edge at the back—this is how we'll build our hive!
- Make as many hexagons as you like let's fill the hive with creativity!
