

THE ODD ONE OUT QUILT PATTERN PDF

My original thinking for this pattern is not to be “mysterious” in the way of only doing a section at a time and waiting impatiently for The Reveal, but to be a FRIENDSHIP quilt. The idea is that YOU choose your own solid/tone-on-tone colour fabrics and exchange a pack of “unknown-to-each-other” printed fabrics with a friend. This is how you will get “ODD” blocks, because your chosen solid fabrics might not “co-ordinate” with the fabrics you swapped... especially if you stick to your original choices! This, for me, is where the mystery lies: the mystery of how friendship is cemented by a common interest and love for such a diverse “hobby” - for whom has the audacity to describe quilting as just a hobby?!

This pattern screams versatility, and is ideal for a beginner, as they could just make 1 of each block and finish it as a table runner. It could become 6 pillows, one block per pillow! For the more experienced quilter it holds charm and an intriguing challenge. They could choose to use a limited palette for instance. Since all the blocks are improvisational, a lot of variations could be sparked off from the “What If...” section that is in every Quilter’s Brain. It’s just plain fun!

This pattern will be available for sale as a PDF at only R120, until the Fynbos Quilt Festival in October.
